**Building spiritual leaders** 

**Strengthens Families and communities** 

Core Vision: Develop a purpose statement that aligns with church values

## **Planning and Initial Steps**

#### Pray for Guidance

Seek God's direction and support

#### Gain Leadership Support

Involve church pastors and elders

#### Form a Core Team

Assign specific roles for planning and leadership

### IDENTIFYING THE TARGET AUDIENCE

- Understanding Needs:
  - Assess spiritual, emotional, and practical needs
- Defines Key Demographics:
  - Younger men, fathers, retirees, etc.
  - Tailor programs to diverse groups

## CRAFTING MINISTRY GOALS

- Spiritual Growth
  - Bible Study
- Fellowship:
  - Men's retreats & social events

- Services Opportunities
- Leadership Development
- Training and teaching opportunities

#### LAUNCHING THE MINISTRY

- Plan a kick-off Event:
   Guest speakers and fellowship activities
- Promote the Ministry
   Church announcements, social media, and personal invites

- Provide Clear Onboarding
- Share the purpose and calendar of events

# CREATING AN ONGOING FRAMEWORK

- Regular Meetings: Weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly schedules
- Bible Studies: Provide materials and foster accountability
- Support Groups: Address specific needs such as marriage or addiction
- Mentorship Programs: Pair younger men with experienced leaders

#### **BUILDING COMMUNITY**

- Encourage Authentic Relationships: Foster vulnerability and support in small groups
- Outreach Efforts: Host open events and collaborate with other ministries.

### **MAINTAINING MOMENTUM**



Gather RegularFeedback:

Assess participation and spiritual growth.

**Leadership Rotation:** 

Train new leaders to sustain the ministry

• Celebrate Milestones:

Acknowledge achievements and growth stories
